

Mountain Operations Manager

Job Title: Mountain Manager

Job Summary: The Mountain Manager coordinates multiple departments such as Lift Maintenance, Grooming, Snowmaking, Mountain Utility, Tubing, Terrain Park, and, Mountain Biking, The Mountain Manager also coordinates Mountain Projects and Maintenance.

Description of Duties and Responsibilities: The Mountain Manager is a managerial position. Duties include coordinating the operations of multiple departments, quality control, working on special projects, maintaining government compliance, hiring, enforcing workplace safety, coordinating and assisting other departments, monitoring employee performance, and maintaining equipment and supplies. Must have good communication skills and promote a positive environment. This position reports to the General Manager.

Qualifications: 10+ years multi-departmental ski industry related experience required. Position requires knowledge of ski area operations and previous managerial experience. Carpentry skills, mechanical skills and the ability to assist other departments and personnel when call upon.

Work Environment, Physical, & Safety Requirements: Position requires the safe operation of heavy equipment, use of power tools, hiking in variable conditions, lifting/pulling objects up to 50 lbs., working outdoors in extreme conditions, and working above ground on lift tower and snow gun assemblies.

Work Schedule: This is a full time permanent salaried position. The work schedule will include weekends, holidays, and nights. Work hours are variable depending on priorities, environmental factors, and operational schedules.

Work Benefits: Pay depends upon experience. Benefits include food discount, seasonal pass, family season pass, retail discount, health/dental/vision insurance, 401K plan, and vacation.
