## **BARTENDER**

JOB TITLE: Bartender

JOB SUMMARY: Bartenders provide quality beverage service to guests in MSSP food and beverage venues. This includes Sliders Bar and other areas of the resort.

JOB DUTIES: Bartenders serve customers beverages that range from soda to beer, wine and mixed drinks. Bartenders should possess a pleasant demeanor and have excellent customer service skills. Bartenders are responsible for coordinating an individual workstation and providing a quick service experience that exceeds our guest's expectations. Ensuring an accurate accounting of all transactions, collections and disbursements. Applicants must be able to accurately pour of beer, wine and hard alcohol. Ability to learn/follow cocktail recipes is required. Applicant is responsible for learning and following ABC regulations and MSSP rules concerning serving alcoholic beverages. Must work well under pressure and shall at all times demonstrate cooperative behavior towards co-workers, supervisors and guests. Other duties as assigned, may include working in other departments.

QUALIFICATIONS: Must be at least 21 years old. No experience required, but prefer job related work experience with demonstrated competence. Demonstrates commitment to guest satisfaction and positive employee and company relations. Candidate must have excellent customer service skills.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK ENVIRONMENT: Mt. Shasta Ski Park is located at 5,500 ft. elevation. Winter conditions can be severe with sub zero temperatures, high wind and heavy snow. While most of the work is performed inside, employees are expected to park in employee parking and walk to the lodge, approximately 5 minutes. Sliders Bar is a fast paced, full bar. Bartenders may work banquets, weddings or other upscale events at the park. Uniform items will be issued.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENT: Requires standing and or walking for extended periods of time. Must be able to lift 25+ pounds. Must demonstrate ability to bend, handle, reach, grasp and perform repetitive motions.

WORK SCHEDULE: This is a seasonal full or part time position. Depending on snow conditions, the season typically runs from mid December to mid April. The schedule will include weekends, holiday and evenings. Morning shifts typically start at 8:45 am. Swing shifts typically start at 2:00 pm. It is your responsibility to report to work on time. Schedules are subject to change without notice depending the needs of the Park.

Reports to: This position reports to the Food & Beverage Manager.

Benefits: This is a non-exempt hourly position. Pay is hourly and based on experience. Benefits include season pass (family pass after 2 seasons) food and retail discounts.
