RENTAL SHOP TECH (CERTIFIED)

JOB TITLE: Rental Shop Tech II

JOB SUMMARY: Certified Rental Shop Techs are primarily responsible for the issuance of skis and snowboards although sometimes they will be called upon to help with boot fitting as well. Waxing, repairing and equipment testing are also part of the job.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: This employee will be required to attend a certification clinic put on by the ski binding company representative. Once certified, this employee will be indemnified, by the manufacturer to legally adjust and fit their bindings for customers. In-season binding testing program and back shop equipment repair and waxing are other duties as well as equipment returns, housekeeping and helping with boot fitting when necessary. All shop employees must work well under pressure, handling multiple tasks simultaneously and at all times demonstrating cooperative behavior with co-workers, customers and supervisory staff. Other duties as assigned, may include working in other departments.

QUALIFICATIONS: Must be willing to acquire manufacturers binding certification once hired.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK ENVIRONMENT: Mt. Shasta Ski Park is located at 5,500 ft. elevation. Winter conditions can be severe with sub freezing temperatures, high winds and heavy snow. While most of the work is performed inside, the employee is expected to park their vehicle in employee parking and walk to the rental shop approximately 5 minutes. Uniform items will be issued.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS: Must be able to stand for 6 – 8 hours and lift more than 30 pounds. Employee must repetitively place and remove boots from overhead shelves, pull skis and snowboards from rack and adjust bindings with hand tools. The work pace can be very hectic and the ability to move quickly is essential.

WORK SCHEDULE: This is a full or part time seasonal position. Depending on snow conditions, the season typically runs from mid December to mid April. The employee is expected to stay until they are laid off from their job duties. Shifts typically start at 7:30am and end at 5:00pm. This schedule will include weekends, holidays and evenings. This schedule may change without notice depending on the needs of the Ski Park.

REPORTS TO: This position reports to the Department Supervisor or appointed senior staff member.

BENEFITS: This is a non-exempt hourly position. Pay is hourly and based on experience. Benefits include season pass and retail/food discounts.
