Job Title: Snowmaker

Job Summary: The position of snowmaker is responsible for making artificial snow at the Mt. Shasta Ski Park.

Description of Duties and Responsibilities: Technical responsibilities include operating snowmaking guns, laying hose, working with high voltage systems, air pressure, and with a high pressure water delivery system. Must have knowledge of meteorology, snow gun capabilities, placement, and ability to make quantity and quality snow. Other duties as assigned may include working in other departments.

Qualifications: Must be 18 years of age, good physical condition, receive and carry out instructions, as well as work under difficult environment conditions. Prior snowmaking experience preferred, but not required.

Description of Work Environment: Mt. Shasta Ski Park is at an elevation of 5,500 feet. Position requires working outdoors, under darkness; sub zero temperatures, handling water, and on varied terrain with ice & snow. Uniform items will be issued.

Physical and Safety Requirements: Position requires being in good physical conditions with ability to hike, stand, shovel snow, and lift/drag up to 50 lbs for periods up to four hours. Employee is required to have winter footwear, wool head protection, flashlight, and winter gloves. Eye and ear protection equipment will be provided.

Work Schedule: The position is a full time seasonal position. The schedule of work is "Call When Needed" driven by current and forecasted weather expected for nights, weekends, and holidays. Work schedule will change; as well as other duties will be assigned up to 40 hours week.

Reports To: Position reports to the Lead Snowmaker

Benefits: This is an hourly full time seasonal position. Pay is hourly and is based on experience. Benefits include employee season pass (family pass after two seasons), food and retail store discounts.
